

HIGHLIGHTS


- Colorado (CO) is a diverse state with 64 counties, of which 17 are urban, 24 are rural, and 23 are frontier
- CO's diversity includes highly populated cities with multiple healthcare partners, 18 counties without any hospitals, and large regions divided by mountainous land
- Several statewide advisory committees with representation from rural and urban healthcare facilities participate in strategic planning for HPP, including the Health Care Coalition Council (HCCC)

SPOTLIGHT ON PLANNING: At-Risk Populations

CO developed its own mapping site, Community Inclusion in Colorado (CICO), which includes HHS emPOWER data as well as many other sources, to assist with planning for at-risk populations in disasters. In addition to the mapping system, the Community Inclusion Coordinator works with HCCs to incorporate whole community planning through their CO Community Inclusion and Health in Disasters Workgroup.

FY 2018 PRIORITIES

- **Countermeasures & Mitigation:** Engage with HCCs to identify and assess state and regional medical caches of pharmaceutical and non-pharmaceutical inventories
- **Community Resilience:** Mature nine new regional HCCs through formal governance, funding and core membership; assist in identification of HCC gaps, risks, and preparedness plans
- **Surge Management:** Ensure HCCs and their members receive training on Colorado's Crisis Standards of Care Plan
