

HIGHLIGHTS

- The Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) is a group of 607 small islands in the Western Pacific about 2,500 miles south-west of Hawaii. FSM has four island states with a combined population of about 102,400
- There are five hospitals in FSM (four publicly-supported and one private), three private medical clinics, and many public health centers and dispensaries. The bed sizes of the public-supported hospitals vary by island
- Jurisdictional threats include the annual possibility of typhoons and infectious disease outbreaks, such as Dengue Fever, Chikungunya and Zika virus

SPOTLIGHT ON PREPAREDNESS: Preparedness Summit

Every other year, FSM supports a jurisdictional Public Health and Preparedness Summit where HCC members, FSM Department of Health preparedness staff, important local government leaders, (e.g. those on the FSM Preparedness Committee), village mayors and local residents all come together for a week of workshops. These workshops include tabletop exercises and discussions on planning and preparedness. These provide input to complete many preparedness grant applications, including HPP. The next FSM Preparedness Summit will be January 22 – 25, 2019 in Chuuk, FSM.

FY 2018 PRIORITIES

- **Community Resilience:** Sustain development of the HCC's emergency standards of operations (SOPs) based on FSM emergency plans and incorporate into exercises, and continue to develop operational response capabilities
- **Incident Management:** Synchronize HCC operations with the development of an all hazards response plan
- **Countermeasures and Mitigation:** Pre-position and inventory (in the states) Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to support the HCC response plan, and use during exercise
- **Surge Management:** Develop medical surge SOPs for HCC emergency response actions
