



Provide clear, consistent, measurable definitions.	11
Establish a stakeholder committee to advise on the questions (including States, HPP, CDC, and hospital representatives)	11
Provide feedback and publish lessons learned to build evidence base to Awardees on the data submitted. Evaluate literature whenever possible.	11
Reduce the number of data elements collected by using valid, reliable criteria and. For example, combine D1, D3, and D4 and lessen ESAR-VHP questions	7
Vet the template and release it with the funding opportunity application/earlier communication of grant guidance. Utilize web-based template pre-population.	6
Involve the right stakeholders early in the process. Be clear about decision authority. Include evaluation during planning, not after.	4
C1 and C3 should measure partnerships and coalitions (eliminate focus on hospitals).	4
Ensure consistency of data sets and streamline collection. Avoid data mining	3
Enable customization of template for individual hospitals and enable aggregation of data by awardee.	3
Leverage public opinion/constituents. Dollar requirement: leadership engagement. Include analysis, not just implementation.	2
Revise H1 to collect the number of patients who can be maintained in negative pressure isolation at one time.	1


Measures the Matter Most, By Vote (Cumulative)
