Recognizing that September 10th was the one year anniversary of Hurricane Irma, this meeting falls on the 17th anniversary of the 9/11 terror attacks, and Hurricane Florence is set to hit this week, issues of preparedness and resiliency are increasingly relevant. The goal of the Metrics of Baseline Vulnerability in Pediatric Health Care Services report was to identify characteristics that can lead to variation between

communities' ability to recover from a disaster. Dr. Needle provided an overview of the report task and metrics identified. The NACCD developed these metrics during a 1-2 hour session during an in-person [public meeting on June 28th, 2018](#).
